
Apparent Causes:

- **♦** Lack of Systematic Knowledge Management/Transfer
- **♦** Lack of Safety Consciousness
- Regulatory and Academic Capture

Root Causes:

- **◆** Lack of Learning/Questioning Attitudes
- **♦** Poorly-Developed 'Safety Culture'
- **♦** Complacency, 'Mindset'
- Closed Mono-Cultured Community
 - 'Groupthink'


